

RIDING AT WEC UNDER THE COVID PROTECTION FRAMEWORK – ORANGERED as a 19 April 2022

As at the 19th of April, we are in the Covid Protection Framework, Orange level @ WEC. As such, our WEC Orange protocols will be reinstated immediately. These will remain in place while we are at Orange and will be reviewed in line with advice received from the Government, ESNZ, MPI and/or Sport New Zealand. We will review as we can, but unless you receive an email removing these, please consider them live.

Effective immediately, the following applies for both financial members and Registered Casual Members:

1. Membership. Everyone who rides @ WEC must have a membership (this does not apply if you only ride here at competitions). This can be either a full riding membership, a summer financial membership or a Registered Casual membership ***Please see item 4 below re casual riding fees. You join on EvoEvents via this link: <https://evoevents.co.nz/joinClub> . The cost for casual membership is \$0, but the \$30 per horse applies as per item 4 below.

Registered Casual members are required to be a member for a minimum of 24 hours prior to the first time they use the property. Membership only needs to be done once per membership year. You will receive an email confirming your membership is active – you are not allowed to ride @ WEC unless this has been received. These requirements are not negotiable.

2. Pre-booking.

a. Financial Members - no pre-booking requirement.

b. Registered Casual Members - You are to book your ride using the WEC Casual Members Schooling for MONTH on evoevents.co.nz (there will be an event loaded for each month). Payment is required at the time by Polipay. \$30 per horse. This can be done on the morning you wish to ride at WEC, but payment must be made by Polipay - no other option is accepted. If you cannot select a particular day, this means that the day has a prior booking and is not available for casual riding.

3. Prior to coming to WEC, please check the Areas Currently Open page on the website. It changes frequently with where the horses are grazing and if any areas are shut for other reasons. You cannot ride in any areas that are closed.

4. Upon arrival on site: you text in when you arrive and out when you leave (027 499 5055).

5. Other rules. All other rules relating to falls, incidents, breakages remain the same.

6. Masks – not required when outdoors. However, if you are coming into any indoor areas (Riverside office, Riding School office, WEC Second-hand shop), a mask must be worn at all times.

7. Sanitising while on site. There will be some sanitiser bottles put at strategic places as well as soap. We strongly urge everyone coming on site to wash their hands thoroughly and/or to sanitise regularly.

8. Physical distancing. While on site, we expect all present to adhere to a minimum of 2m distance from everyone else who is not in your bubble.

9. Unwell/sickness. If you or anyone who is coming with you are feeling unwell or have any symptoms whatsoever, however mild, we request that you do not come onto site.

10. These rules have been put in place to ensure the safety of everyone on site. Any breaches will result in disciplinary action. The Disciplinary Policy can be found on our website using this link: <https://horses.net.nz/index.php/rulesandpolicies/> .

As above, we will be reviewing these requirements regularly to ensure that we can adequately adhere to our lawful requirements.

Any person/s found to not have followed the above protocols will be requested to leave immediately and further action may be taken via the Disciplinary Policy as stated in item 10.
